This scholarship aims to increase awareness of the accounting profession among racial/ethnic minority students and prepare them for success.

Eligibility:

- High school senior going to college in Illinois during the 2021-22 academic year
- Racial/ethnic minority currently underrepresented in the accounting profession (e.g. African American, Hispanic/Latino, etc.)
- Interested in majoring in accounting (completion of a high school accounting course is preferred)
- Have a high school GPA of at least 3.0/4.0 or equivalent
