### LEGISLATIVE

**LEGISLATIVE TRANSITION**-Prepare for legislative transformation with the seating of the 101<sup>st</sup> General Assembly and 45 plus new members elected for the first time.

**TAX ON PROFESSIONAL SERVICES**-The Illinois CPA Society will oppose any legislative initiatives to tax professional services.

**NATIONAL HUMAN RESOURCES/LICENSURE LEGISLATION**-The Illinois CPA Society will respond to nationally identified human resource and professional licensure issues impacting the CPA profession.

**ILLINOIS COMPTROLLER GOV'T AUDITS** -Introduce legislation making technical corrections to the Municipal, County and Government Audit Acts.

### REGULATORY

*Accounting Act Administrative Rules*-Work with leadership and General Counsel of the Illinois Department of Financial and Professional Regulation to update the Public Accounting Administrative Rules to include Continuing Professional Education Reciprocity and other contemporary updates as needed.
