Marty Green's Capitol Update
Off to the Races

Now that the 103rd General Assembly has formed its newly constituted House and Senate committees, the race officially kicks off to hear and vote on introduced legislation. Both chambers have allocated significant time to meet the March 10 deadline for any introduced bills to advance to a third reading in the chamber of origin. At this time, bill introduction deadlines have passed, and approximately 2,530 bills have been introduced in the Senate and 3,980 in the House.

Our top priority for this legislative session is to pass legislation extending the Accounting Act Sunset from 2024 to 2029. This deliberative sunset process is a legislative mechanism to evaluate the need for occupational and professional licensure acts and to make sure those acts are reflective of contemporary standards. We've worked with the Illinois Department of Financial and Professional Regulation (IDFPR) to create agreed upon legislation that's been introduced and identified below.

Notably, it's still very early in the legislative process and difficult to predict which of the 6,510 introduced bills will be viable. We're closely monitoring legislative proceedings and have curated items of legislative and informational interest below.

March 10, 2023

Good Day!

The House convenes at 9:00 a.m. followed by the Senate at 10:00 a.m. There are no committees posted for today.

RECAP FROM YESTERDAY: The House and Senate were both in session for this week's third day of session. Legislative items of interest that passed out of committee: Small Business Permits (HB3017) requires improvement and interagency cooperation for expeditious permit issuance. Chambers of Commerce Grants (HB 3144) established a program for DECO to provide grants to certified local Chambers of Commerce. Automatic Contract Renewal (HB3478) requires disclosure of automatic contract renewals. AI Task Force (HB 3553) requires the Dept. of Innovation Technology (DOIT) to establish the Generative AI and Natural Language Processing Task Force. Procurement (SB 2192) regarding the State Procurement Code, requires an agency to provide a written response to a bidder who failed to be awarded a contract after 4 consecutive bids outlining the reasons why the 4 bids were rejected.

Bill Information

HB1095 CRIMINAL LAW-TECH (SLAUGHTER II)

Senate Floor Amendment Rto. 1: Replaces everything after the enacting clause. Makes changes to various provisions of Public Act 101-052, concerning pretrial release. Amends the State Finance Act. Establishes the Public Defender Fund. The State Treasury requires money in the Public Defender Fund to be used, subject to appropriation, to provide a public defender and public defender services. Amends the Counties Code requires the Administrative Office of the subject to appropriation, to establish a grant program for counties for the purpose of training and hiring attorney the county public defender in pretrial detention hearings. Authorizes the Administrative Office of the Illinois Code.
