Overview and History

Mary T. Washington Wylie (1906-2005) was the first female Black/African American CPA in the United States. With odds stacked against her at every turn, she overcame barriers and founded an accounting firm in her basement on the South Side of Chicago. She was a trailblazer and mentor who created opportunities for generations of aspiring Black/African American CPAs by building a sense of belonging and generously fostering their development and supporting their careers.

As a tribute to honor her legacy, the CPA Endowment Fund of Illinois' Mary T. Washington Wylie Opportunity Fund was founded by Lester McKeever Jr., CPA, JD, former managing principal for Washington, Pittman & McKeever, LLC. This fund offers the community an opportunity to help pave the way for diverse individuals interested in the accounting and finance profession.



Mary T. Washington Wylie Internship Preparation Program Changes Underrepresented Demographics in the Profession



For more than ten years, the Illinois CPA Society and CPA Endowment Fund of Illinois have partnered with accounting faculty and several accounting firms and organizations to hold the Mary T. Washington Wylie Internship Preparation Program, a 2015 recipient of the "Power of A" Gold Award from the American Society of Association Executives.

The three-day, all expenses paid program is available to qualifying students each year. The goal is to prepare and place Black/African American and other minority sophomore, junior, and senior accounting students in successful internships through exposure to the profession, practical training, financial resources, access to mentors, and internship interviews. The program attracts students from schools where accounting firms do not typically recruit, providing access and educational opportunities to individuals who otherwise may not receive them. All students receive a \$500 scholarship to help pay for educational expenses. In addition, through a unique partnership with the University of Illinois, these students receive the opportunity to interview for a free tuition and stipend scholarship for the Master of Accounting Science program. The next Internship Preparation Program is in development for January 2024.
